GRAD NITE 2022 EXPECTATIONS:

1. Check in between 8:45pm and 10:00pm. Students who arrive later than 10:00pm will not be admitted. [Students must bring their ID or driver's license to confirm attendance](#). Be sure to let us know if your emergency contact information has changed in case we need to call home.
2. Students may not leave early. We will deal with emergencies on a case by case situation. Please make sure both parents understand this! [If your senior has a special and unique situation that requires them to leave early, we must have a written notice to the GN chair prior to the evening. \(westviewgradnite@gmail.com\)](#)
3. Parents need to pick up seniors at 5:00am sharp when the event ends. Students will be very tired and driving may not be safe under those conditions.
4. [Seniors may have their cell phones and iWatches on them if they use them appropriately and kindly. Seniors are responsible for their own devices. They may check in their phone at coat check.](#)
5. Students who require to take medication during the event must follow the PUSD's guidelines and have [form](#) on file with district to properly carry medication. GN Medical Team will NOT hold or administer any prescribed or OTC medication.
6. Students MUST wear the Grad Nite 2022 t-shirt - this is the "admission ticket" and will be distributed at the Senior breakfast or the Senior picnic. Dress for a regular school day but must wear close-toed shoes and should bring a light jacket.
7. Be aware that Grad Nite features food and drinks all night for seniors. Do not bring food or water bottles.
8. Students who arrive under the influence will not be allowed in. Parents (or police) will be called.
9. NO outside food, beverages, containers, backpacks, gum, weapons, vaping equipment or cigarettes of any kind will be allowed for the duration of the event.
